



Womb op mum bleeds to death as she's left with rookie doctor

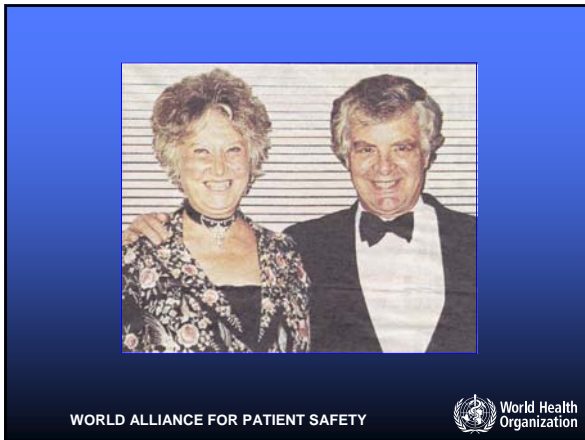
A 35-year-old mother died in hospital after a routine operation on her womb, but her death was avoidable, a report says. The woman, who was left with a rookie doctor, died after a major operation on her womb. The report says the death was avoidable and that the hospital should have been better prepared for the possibility of a major complication. The doctor involved in the operation was a rookie and had not performed the procedure before. The report also says that the hospital's staff were not properly trained to deal with such complications. The woman's family is seeking compensation for her death.

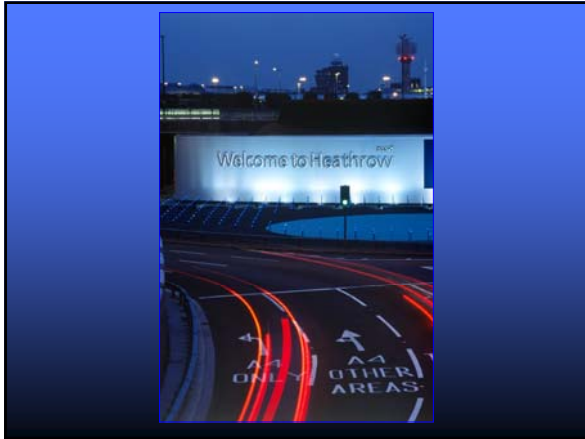




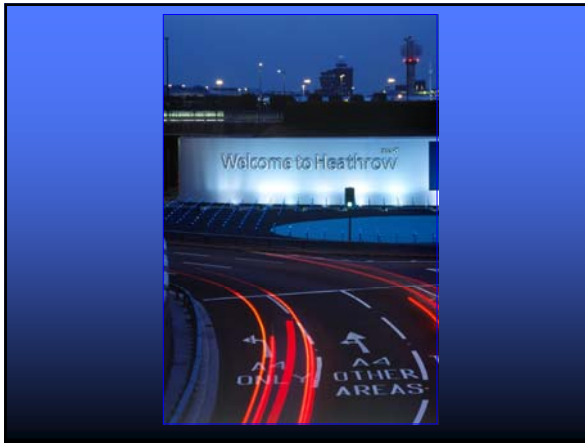

Assessing Risk Resilience

Acceptable risk resilience: as close to safety as believed can be achieved

Reduced risk resilience: processes for dealing with risk not as effective as could be

Degraded risk resilience: few or no systematic defences to stop an error having serious consequences

Intrathecal safety protocols

- New guidelines issued in 2001
- Follow up one year - 34% of hospitals reporting non compliance
- Follow up 18 months - all hospitals report compliance
- Independent review at four years - 50% non compliance rate
