The Safety Competencies
Enhancing Patient Safety Across the Health Professions

Potential educational issues identified

- Lack of situational awareness
- Team fixation
- Non assertive communication
- Loss of leadership during crisis
- Loss of sense of knowing the urgency of the situation
- Unfamiliar with process of investigation
- Unable to support the reporting culture
- Unable to support a learning culture
- Unable to respond quickly when things are going poorly
